Historical Enquiry	<ul> <li>Ask and answer questions, choosing and using parts of stories and other sources to demonstrate knowledge and understanding of key features and events</li> <li>Use a range of source material including artefacts and stories to find out about the past</li> <li>Identify different ways in which the past is represented</li> <li>Begin to formulate own questions about the past</li> </ul>		
Historical Terms	<ul> <li>Begin to use specific historical terms to describe the past such as 'century and period'</li> <li>Describe objects, people or events in history using learnt terms</li> </ul>		
Chronological Understanding	<ul> <li>Use a timeline to place people, events and periods in order</li> <li>Use a timeline to place new learning in context with prior learning</li> </ul>		
Historical interpretation	<ul> <li>Identify different ways in which the past is represented</li> <li>Identify which sources (from a selection) are likely to be the most useful for a task</li> </ul>		
Continuity and change	<ul> <li>Identify what has stayed the same and what has changed</li> <li>Identify how one thing changes over a period of time</li> </ul>		
Cause and consequence	<ul> <li>Understand what a consequence is and give examples.</li> <li>Recognise actions and events are both cause and consequence</li> <li>Recognise that an event or action can cause a range of consequences</li> <li>Understand the link between cause and consequence of an event or action</li> </ul>		
Similarity and difference	<ul> <li>Identify similarities and differences within a period of time and between different periods of time</li> <li>Compare the similarities and differences between the actions of 2 significant individuals who have contributed to national and international achievements</li> </ul>		
Significance	<ul> <li>Understand the term 'significant' and give some examples.</li> <li>Identify the reasons for historical significance</li> </ul>
